

THE LEON MAYO SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

The Harrodsburg Kiwanis Club is giving away two, five hundred dollar (\$500) scholarships in honor of our former club President, Leon Mayo. In the spirit in which Leon lived, and served his community, these scholarships will be awarded to two deserving high school seniors who have focused on both academic excellence and community service.

Requirements:

*The student must be an actively enrolled senior from the Mercer County School District, Burgin School District, or Home Schooled in Mercer County. The student must be in good standing with no disciplinary issues.

*Applicant must be planning to enroll in an accredited post-secondary educational or training institution of his/her choice.

*At least one of the applicant's parents must be a resident of Mercer County.

*To receive the scholarship money provided by the Leon Mayo Scholarship, the recipient must provide vouchers or bills for the money due from the institution of higher education of his/her choice. Scholarship money may be used to pay for books, tuition, housing, lab fees, or any other costs directly related to the school. No money will be given directly to the recipient. Scholarship money cannot be used for clothing, transportation, furnishings, appliances, telephone, or food.

*Scholarships are not renewable.

*Applicant will be judged on financial need, community service record, and academic excellence (GPA and ACT Score), written testament about community service, and teacher/mentor recommendations.
