<p><b>KCWP 2: Design and Deliver Instruction</b>            What evidence is there that your instruction is highly effective, culturally responsive, evidence-based, and provided to all students in the classroom?</p>	<p>Classroom observations by school and district staff, Daily walkthroughs by school administrative team and instructional coaches, Professional development trainings and webinars</p>
<p><b>KCWP 3: Design and Deliver Assessment Literacy</b>            What evidence is there that you have a balanced assessment system, including classroom assessment for student learning?</p>	<p>Formative and summative assessments, Common assessments in core content areas</p>
<p><b>KCWP 4: Review, Analyze and Apply Data</b>            What evidence is there that you have an established system for examining and interpreting all the data that is in schools (e.g., formative, summative, benchmark, and interim assessment data) in order to determine priorities for individual student success?</p>	<p>PLC's, Department meetings, School Instructional MTSS meetings, Instructional coaches meeting with staff monthly and weekly with administration team</p>
<p><b>KCWP 5: Design, Align and Deliver Support</b>            What evidence is there that a system is in place to monitor student data regularly and to ensure a continuous improvement model that monitors what is working to support student learning?</p>	<p>PLC's, Weekly instructional coaches meetings with administration team, Monthly district instructional MTSS team meetings</p>
<p><b>KCWP 6: Establishing Learning Culture and Environment</b>            What evidence is there that your school creates, nurtures, and sustains a fair and caring learning community in which all students have optimal opportunities for academic success?</p>	<p>MTSS meetings held monthly regarding instruction, procedures, and PBIS. Daily interventions for students that are behind grade level. Weekly SEL lessons for all students</p>
